

Admission criteria:

A satisfactory scholastic average; usually for masters a minimum grade average of "very good" in the bachelor degree of Nursing

- 1. Completion of the application at Alfaisal University
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended
- 3. Application fee (500 SAR) receipt voucher none refundable.
- 4. Preferable to have at least one-year of experience or training.

- 5. English proficiency demonstrated with IELTS scores 5.5 or higher, or TOEFL computer-based score of 220 or above (or equivalent).
- 6. CV
- 7. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or (Qudurat) must be taken within five years.
- 8. Two letters of recommendation from sources able to attest to an applicant's academic ability and clinical character.
- 9. Provide a statement of purpose describing your academic interests and reasons for applying.
- 10. Successfull completion of an in-person interview with the director of the program.
- 11. No student shall be allowed enrolment in two graduate programs at the same time.
